








## **Barwon North Central**



# Creating environments students need in order to succeed

<u>50-60%</u> of some staff or school leadership time/energy at the moment

25-35% of school leadership and some classroom teacher time

> 2-5% of available school leadership and teacher time.

Individualised, specialised behavioural/ mental health supports for up to 5% of students, includes external expertise

Targeted behavioural and mental health supports for 15% of students

Universal behavioural and mental health supports for all students. Proactively supporting 80% of students
