#### The role of the VCAA

- A statutory authority primarily accountable to the Minister for Education
- Serves both government and non-government schools
- Designs, develops and evaluates curriculum and assessment products and services
- Develops and implements:
  - Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework (VEYLDF):
     Birth to 8 years
  - Victorian Curriculum F–10
  - Senior Secondary curriculum (VCE, VM, VPC)

**Reporting** and **pedagogy** sit outside the remit of the VCAA.

Continues to provide a high-quality curriculum that teachers can implement with confidence, including revisions that better meet the needs of Victorian students

Has strengthened the alignment with the Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework (VEYLDF)

Provides the necessary knowledge and skills for senior secondary pathways

Is accompanied by a program of familiarisation and support resources (including professional learning) and monitoring that supports and enables Victorian teachers to implement the Victorian Curriculum F–10 with confidence

Supports the delivery of the next generation of the curriculum in Victorian schools by ensuring the digital platforms are fit for purpose, accessible and user-friendly
