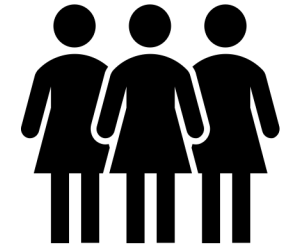

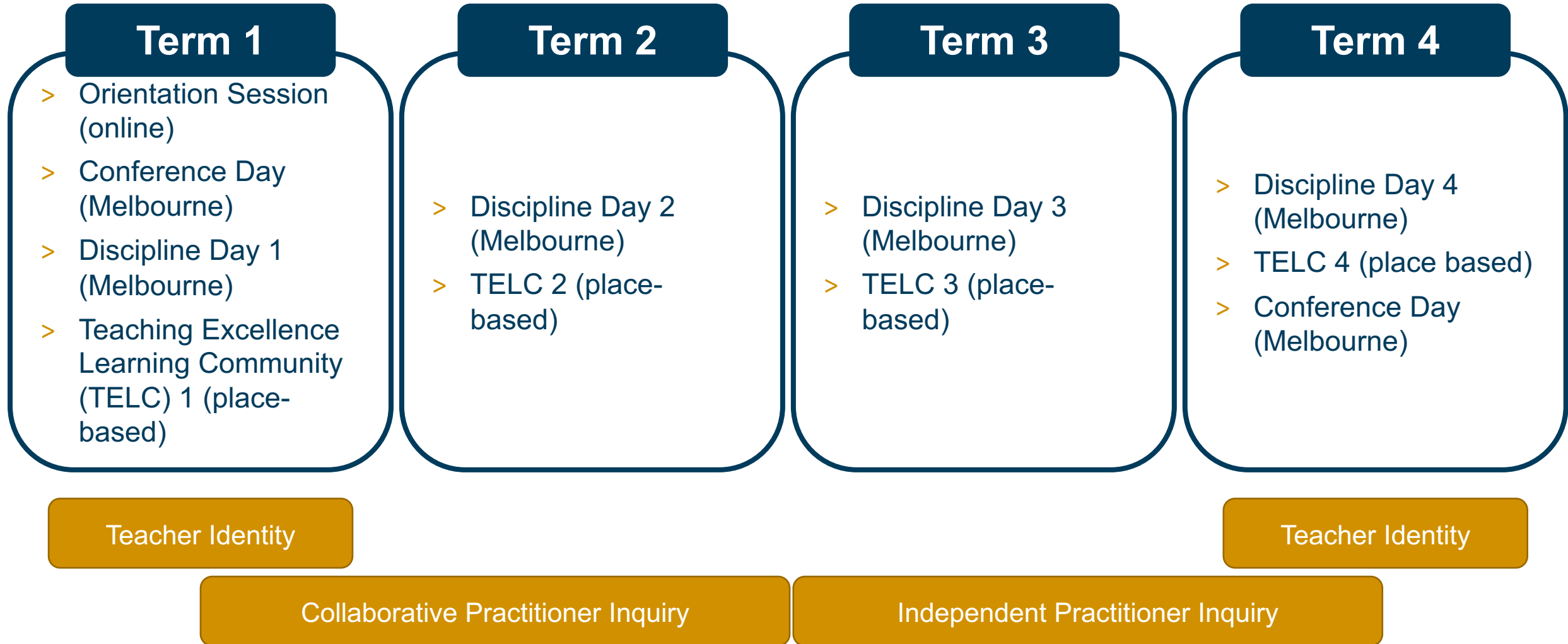

Eligibility


To be eligible for the program teachers must:

- > have minimum 3 years' teaching experience
- > have access to a classroom setting to conduct a practitioner inquiry
- > be in an education-based role in Victoria (full-time or part-time)
- > be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident
- > have full teacher registration with the Victorian Institute of Teaching
- + *have the principal's endorsement and ongoing support (a manager can replace a principal where necessary).*
